INSTRUCTIONS TO SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS

All reports sent to you must be completely filled out and signed before mailing to the Grand Secretary and postmarked not later than April 15th.

- Form MMS-1: Be sure to answer all questions and sign.
Attach your letter of application
- Form MMS-2: Be sure to answer all questions and sign.
Attach a statement of NOT MORE than 100 words on
"What Job's Daughters Means to Me"
- Form MMS-3: This form is for your parent or legal guardian to complete. Be sure all questions are answered. Return the form with your application forms to the Grand Secretary.
- Form MMS-4: This form is to be given or sent to the Principal or Guidance Counselor of your high school or to your college advisor. We would suggest you enclose a stamped envelope addressed to the Grand Secretary. The appropriate person should complete the form and mail it directly to the Grand Secretary.
- Form MMS-5: This form is to be completed in every detail and signed by your Bethel Guardian. The SEAL of the Bethel should be placed in the area indicated. Attached to this form should be a letter from one member of the Executive Bethel Guardian Council. This form and supporting letter should be mailed directly to the Grand Secretary.

Note about eligibility:

According to the laws of the Grand Guardian Council of Nebraska, the recipient of the Mick Memorial Scholarship must be in the upper one-half of her class in high school or college; must be in financial need to further her educational plans; and may not be the holder of a scholarship or scholarship equaling or surpassing the value of the University of Nebraska Regent's scholarship. Each applicant will be asked, at the time award checks are issued, to vouch that her total scholarships do not exceed the value of a Regent's award.

Confidentiality:

All information furnished to the Scholarship Committee will remain in the confidence of the Committee, the Grand Secretary and the Grand Guardian.

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General Instructions

1. All statements and recommendations should be on standard sized paper.
2. Place application in order as follows:
 - a. Form MMS-1
 - b. Letter of application
 - c. Form MMS-2
 - d. Statement: "What Job's Daughters Means to Me"
 - e. Form MMS-3
 - f. Statement of parent or legal guardian
3. Staple in brochure form. Do NOT place in a cover.
4. Grand Secretary will attach forms MMS-4 and MMS-5 when they are received from school personnel and Bethel Guardian Council respectively.
5. Mick Memorial Scholarship application must be in full and should NOT be combined with Masonic Scholarship application. Separate letters of recommendation are needed for each award since they are judged separately.
6. Guidelines for consideration in selecting scholarship winners will be as follows:

	Maximum points
a. Scholastic standing (must be in upper ½ of class)	10
b. School record and school official recommendation	15
c. Financial need	30
d. Job's activities and Bethel Guardian Council recommendation	30
e. Unusual or outstanding achievements	5
f. Church activities	5
g. Community activities	5
7. Neatness and following instructions will also be taken into consideration especially in the case of tie scores.

The Grand Secretary must receive scholarship applications with a postmark no later than the April 15th deadline. The Scholarship Committee will screen all applications and announce the winners at the Grand Guardian Council in June. It is hoped that winners will be present to receive their awards, but attendance at Grand Session is not a criteria for the award.
